It will delve into the benefits around social media marketing and how effective social media marketing campaigns can benefit companies and brands. Over the sessions, we will take a look at current campaigns and trends and start to unpick how and why they have been successful. After studying marketing strategies, students will create a strategy of their own for a company of their choice. Embedded will be tips and tricks on how to create effective content whilst unpicking the importance of a clear strategic plan over pure content creation. The students will get a chance to create their own content on social media platforms of their choice, which will be directly correlating with their previous marketing strategy.

We will focus on the Visual Basic language but the techniques are applicable to a range of other platforms. Over the four sessions, the students will write their own Windows form application. We will start by learning some code and understanding how the language is compiled into commands for the computer. The students will be given examples of completed programs to see their structure and how they operate, including simple robots and games. They will learn about variables, classes, loops and computer logic. The final program will be a simple calculator to take input from the user, have buttons to perform tasks, and display results on screen
